EXTENDING THE STANDING POLE:

Loosen the height adapter on the standing pole .

Then pull the upper inner tube of the standing pole to the desired height and re-tightenthe height adapter



SPEED CONTROL: Select air speed by setting switch to either high-low-off.

CLEANING

WARNING: Unplug from electrical supply source before cleaning.
