PAY AT THE REGISTER, MAIL IN THE POST CARD, INSECTS WILL THEN BE SHIPPED DIRECTLY TO YOU FROM THE FARM.



RELEASE INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Shipped as ready-to-hatch pupae enclosed in pre-parasitized whitefly pupae fixed to cards.
- 2. Please release these wasps the day of receipt.
- 3. Separate the cards at the perforation by cutting them with scissors. Try not to touch the pupae because they are delicate.
- 4. Hang the cards securely from the middle to upper branches of the infested plants. Place the cards right next to whitefly populations.
- 5. Hang the cards away from the heat of the sun and away from water.
- 6. Leave the cards in place for 10 days.

Storage: Do not store the hatched wasps for more than 4 hours.

Store at a moderately humid 56-66°F. Do not attempt to cold store the unhatched pupae for more than 4 days.
