HOW IT WORKS

CERTAIN INSECTS ARE PERISHABLE AND TIME SENSITIVE AND ARE BEST IF MAILED DIRECTLY TO THE CUSTOMER. THIS PACKAGE CONTAINS ONE PRE-PRINTED POST CARD. PAY AT THE REGISTER, MAIL IN THE POST CARD, INSECTS WILL THEN BE SHIPPED DIRECTLY TO YOU FROM THE FARM.



RELEASE INSTRUCTIONS

1. Red Worms are packaged in ventilated containers mixed with soil and food.
2. Red Worms will vary in size. Packages include eggs, newborn worms and adults. Mature size will be reached (about three inches in length) in 6 to 12 months.
3. Make sure your release site is moist.
4. Worms should be scattered on top of the soil of gardens, potted plants or lawns.
5. Release in the evening after watering. Worms will then burrow into the earth and immediately begin their soil improving tasks.
6. If placing the worms in your garden, do several release sites.
7. For compost piles, simply add the worms to your bins and the worms will seek out the food.
