RELEASE INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Predators are highly perishable!
- Release them the same day as received. Early morning, late afternoon, or when temperatures are not extremely hot. Cloudy days are perfect.
- 3. Allow predators to warm up to room temperature and release immediately.
- Mites are fragile do not shake. Apply by sprinkling onto dry foliage.
- 5. Begin releases at first sign of Thrips.
- 6. Do not release immediately before or after pesticide applications.

Storage: If not using immediately, keep in a cool (42-50°F) dark place out of direct sunlight

Cucumeris is a species of predatory mite that feeds on immature stages of Thrips. It also feeds on pollen, Two Spotted Mites and other species of mites. Cucumeris adults are pear-shaped, tan colored mites, less than 0.5mm long. Upon purchasing, open the lid and shake the contents onto leaves or at the base of plant stems.

General release is 5-20 mites per sq.ft., bi-weekly, 3-4 times.

Pay at the register, mail in the post card and insects will be shipped directly to you from the farm.

Complete release instructions are included with insects. Purchase price includes shipping charges.
